

David Mills came to Christ out of a secular background as a sixteen-year-old junior at Lemoore High School in California. His church modeled Christ for him and he soon began to share the gospel. Not long after his conversion and baptism, God directed him into ministry and to East Texas Baptist University. Since graduation from ETBU, he has attended and graduated from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary (MDiv) and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary (PhD, ThM).

Through the years, David has served churches in Texas, the Carolinas, and Alabama, the Baptist state convention staff in Georgia in the Evangelism office, and Southwestern Seminary teaching evangelism and missions.
