On **Wednesday, June 19th**, we will have a **very short informational meeting regarding the May 2020 trip** before WOW at 5:30pm in

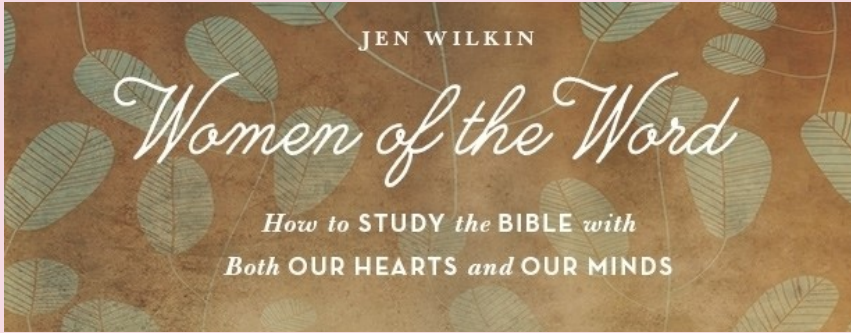
